AN ORDINANCE BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA IMPOSING A ONE HUNDRED AND TWENTY (120) DAY MORATORIUM ON THE ACCEPTANCE OF APPLICATIONS FOR PERMITS, LICENSES OR INSPECTIONS RELATED TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF PERSONAL SERVICE ESTABLISHMENTS, URGENT MEDICAL CARE FACILITIES, CONVENIENCE STORES, BEAUTY SUPPLY STORES, EVENT CENTERS, TIRE STORES, DISCOUNT VARIETY STORES, RESALE SHOPS, NAIL SUPPLY STORES, TAX PREPARATION BUSINESSES; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO PROVIDE FOR AN ADOPTION DATE AND EFFECTIVE DATE; TO PROVIDE A PENALTY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
