**Mayor John J. Lampl II** called the Regular Council Meeting of the Morrow City Council to order at 7:41pm on March 9, 2021. The meeting took place in the Council Chambers of the Morrow Municipal Complex located at: 1500 Morrow Rd, Morrow, and GA 30260.

**Mayor John Lampl, Councilwoman Dorothy Dean, Councilwoman Renee Knight and Councilman Khoa Vuong** were present in person; **Mayor Pro Tem Van Tran** was present remotely.

**Mayor Lampl** asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance, followed by a moment of silent reflection.

### **1. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:**

**MOTION AND VOTE:** **Mayor Lampl** called for a motion to approve the agenda with the two following additions under New Business.

Item 3: The approval of the Memorandum of Understanding between Atlanta Technical College and City of Morrow Fire Department to provide grant funded Advance Emergency Medical Technician training.

Item 4: The approval of the Assignment Agreement between New Image Towing and Recovery, Inc. and Marietta Wrecker.

**Councilman Vuong** made the motion to approve the amended agenda, seconded by **Dorothy Dean**, the motion passed unanimously.

### 3. NEW BUSINESS:

1. Approval of Scope Changes from Pond Co. for a re-review of the plans for Jester's Creek Phase III in the amount of \$1,200 from SPLOST 2008.

**MOTION AND VOTE:** Mayor Lampl called for a motion to approve scope changes and to authorize Mayor Lampl to execute any related documents. Councilman Vuong made the motion, seconded by Councilwoman Dean. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Approval of Public Work's sign replacement package from 2014 SPLOST in the amount of \$3,602.

**MOTION AND VOTE:** Mayor Lampl called for a motion to approve the sign expenditure from SPLOST 2014. Mayor Pro Tem Tran made the motion, seconded by Councilman Vuong. Mayor Lampl called for a vote. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Approval of the Memorandum of Understanding between Atlanta Technical College and City of Morrow Fire Department to provide the grant funded Advance Emergency Medical Technician training.

**MOTION AND VOTE:** Mayor Lampl called for a motion to approve the Memorandum of Understanding and for approval for the Mayor to execute any related documents. Councilwoman Dean made the motion, seconded by Councilman Vuong. Mayor Lampl called for a vote. The motion passed unanimously.

4. Approval of the Assignment Agreement between New Image Towing and Recovery, Inc. and Marietta Wrecker.

**MOTION AND VOTE:** Mayor Lampl called for a motion to approve the assignment and for approval for the Mayor to execute the agreement and any other related documents. Councilman Vuong made the motion, seconded by Councilwoman Dean. Mayor Lampl called for a vote. The motion passed unanimously with 4 votes.
