### **1. APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA:**

**MOTION AND VOTE:** Mayor Lampl called for a motion to approve to add two new items to the agenda; New Business Item 7 Perkins Generator in the amount of 25,414.40 from SPLOST 2020 and Resolution 2021-10 The Little Library. Councilman Vuong made the motion, seconded by Councilwoman Dean, the motion passed unanimously.
