2. **SWEARING IN OF DEPUTY CHIEF DAVID SNIVEL:** Chief Renan Lopez de Azua gave the introduction and Mayor Lampl performed the Swearing In Ceremony for Chief David Snivel, in company were his family, friends, many officers from the Morrow Police Department, Councilwoman Dorothy Dean, Councilwoman Renee Knight, Councilman Khoa Vuong, Councilwoman Tran (remotely) and Mayor John Lampl.

4. PRESENTATIONS:

Chief Swint showed pictures of the new Ladder truck and also thanked Council for the purchase and explained how tax dollars were saved based on the amount of the purchase. The Ladder truck can hold up to 3 firefighters safely and allows firefighter the ability to help trapped victims and safely lower them to the ground. He advised the new Ladder Truck was available for everyone to view after the meeting was adjourned.

5. NEW BUSINES:

1. Approval of Staff Recommendation to purchase two new Digital Screens for The Welcome Signs from Formetco in the amount \$66,668.14 from SPLOST 2020: and to authorize Mayor Lampl to execute the contract and any other related documents.

2. Approval of application and execution of forms related to ARPA Law Enforcement and First Responders Supplement-Match: and to authorize Mayor Lampl to execute the agreement and any other related documents.

MOTION AND VOTE: Councilwoman Knight called for a motion for the approval of application and execution of forms related to ARPA Law Enforcement and First Responders Supplement-Match and for the City to match the governor's grant for first responders and provide the \$1000 match amount to all other City employees full-time and part-time to include covering payroll tax and benefits so that all employees will benefit from receiving the full amount of the appropriate grant and approvable City match. Councilwoman Tran seconded, the motion passed unanimously.

3. Approval of Public works recommendation to purchase a 2014 Dodge Ram 5500 replacement Bucket Truck from Pinnacle Bucket Georgia in the amount of \$44,999 from SPLOST 2020: and to surplus a 2004 Ford F-450 Bucket Truck; and to authorize Mayor Lampl to execute any contracts and any other related document.

MOTION AND VOTE: Mayor Lampl called for a motion to approve the recommendation from Public works to purchase a 2014 Dodge Ram 5500 replacement Bucket truck from Pinnacle Bucket Georgia in the amount of \$44,999 from the SPLOST 2020, and to surplus a 2004 Ford F-450 Bucket Truck. Councilwoman Dean made the motion, seconded by Councilman Khoa. Councilwoman Dean, Councilman Vuong, and



Councilwoman Knight voted "Yay" and Councilwoman Tran voted "Nay". The motion passed 3-1.

4. Approval of Staff Recommendation to purchase a new replacement DC (battery) Tornado Warning Siren in the amount of \$24,377.50 from SPLOST 2020: and to authorize Mayor Lampl to execute the contract and any other related document.

MOTION AND VOTE: Mayor Lampl called for a motion to approve the Staff Recommendation for the Fire Department to purchase a new replacement DC Tornado Warning Siren in the amount of \$24,377.50 from SPLOST 2020. Councilman Vuong made the motion, seconded by Councilwoman Knight, the motion passed unanimously.
