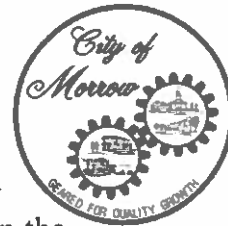

Mayor Lampl called for his original motion to approve the June 28, 2022, Regular Meeting Minutes and works Session Minutes.

Councilwoman Tran made the amend motion to add roll call vote to the June 28, 2022, regular minutes. The motion did not receive a second. Motion failed.

4. NEW BUSINES:

1. Approval to accept the full audit amount of \$23,534.63 Paid in full of Zayo with \$26,817.03 being the original payment minus the 2021 payment of \$3,282.40 leaving balance of \$23,534.63. The 2021 payment was for the audit period of 2018 – 2020 and the City can release all Zayo permits that are being held up. Zayo will be required to remit quarterly payments of 3% to the City from their retail customers going forward: and to authorize the mayor to execute the agreement and any other related documents.

MOTION AND VOTE: **Mayor Lampl** called for a motion to approve full audit amount with Zayo. Councilwoman Knight made the motion. Seconded by Councilman Vuong. Motion passed unanimously.
