1. RESOLUTION 2022-04- LOST OPTION SALES TAX

Every Ten years, to determine the City's share in the LOST, the County and the CC Cities assess the eight criteria in O.C.G.A. 48-8-89(b), including population and the services it provides to its citizens and those residents of unincorporated Clayton County in accordance with the requirements of O.C.G.A. 36-70-20 et seq. (" the Service Delivery Strategy Act"); and the City is in similarly situated with the other six CC Cities in seeking the County's cooperation in determining the CC Cities' share of the LOST;

MOTION AND VOTE: Mayor Lampl called for a motion to approve Resolution 2022-04. Councilwoman Knight made the motion, seconded by councilwoman Tran. **Motion Passed Unanimously.**

2. ORDINANCE 2022-06- Fire Department Fee scheduled Change Second Reading

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 4, PUBLIC SAFETY, CHAPTER 2, FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION, SECTION 4-2-10, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MORROW, AND TO AMEND TITLE 3 FINANCE; CHAPTER 4 SCHEDULE OF FEES; SECTION 3-4-1; TO PROTECT THE CITY FROM EXTRAORDINARY EXPENSES RESULTING FROM THE UTILIZATION OF CITY RESOURCES IN RESPONSE TO CERTAIN PUBLIC SAFETY, FIRE, OR EMERGENCY INCIDENTS OR CONDITIONS, AND TO AUTHORIZE THE IMPOSITION OF CHARGES AND THE METHODS FOR COLLECTION FOR RECOVERING REASONABLE AND ACTUAL COSTS INCURRED IN RESPONDING TO SUCH INCIDENTS OR CONDITIONS.; TO PROVIDE FOR SEVERABILITY; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
