**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-06**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA BY REVISING TITLE 2: GENERAL GOVERNMENT; CHAPTER 3: ADMINISTRATIVE ORGANIZATION; ARTICLE C: CITY ATTORNEY; SECTION 2-3-22: POWERS AND DUTIES; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO PROVIDE AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER LAWFUL PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS:** the duly elected governing authority of the City of Morrow, Georgia (the "City") is the Mayor and Council thereof; and

**WHEREAS:** the Council is authorized by Charter Section 2.19 to introduce legislation that regulates its rules of the procedure; and

**WHEREAS:** the governing authority has determined that it is necessary to amend the rules of procedure concerning the City Attorney Powers and Duties; and

**WHEREAS:** these amendments will assist in creating a procedure that is more narrowly defined, clearer, and more cost effective for the City of Morrow;

**BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA,** and by the authority thereof:

**Section 1:**

Within Title 2: General Government; Chapter 3: Administrative Organization; Article C: City Attorney; Section 2-3-22: Powers and Duties:

Remove numbers (4) – (5) in their entirety and replace them with the following language:

(1) Advise the mayor, council, its committees or any city officer, when thereto requested by the Mayor or majority vote of the Council, upon all legal questions arising in the conduct of city business;

(2) Prepare or revise ordinances when so requested by the Mayor or majority vote of the Council or any committee thereof:

(3) Give their opinion upon any legal matter or question submitted to them by the city manager, Mayor, or a majority vote of the Council:

(4) Attend any council meetings in their entirety upon request of the Mayor or majority vote of the Council for the purpose of giving the mayor and council any legal advice requested of its members.

(5) Prepare for execution all contracts and instruments to which the city is a party when so requested by the Mayor or majority vote of the Council; and approve, as to form, all bonds and city contracts:

**Section 2.** That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.


**Section 3.** That this Ordinance shall be codified in a manner consistent with the laws of the State of Georgia and the City of Morrow.

**Section 4.** That the effective date of this Ordinance shall be the date of adoption unless otherwise specified herein.
