

RESOLUTION NO. 2017- 04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MORROW, GEORGIA, PROVIDING FOR CERTAIN POSITIONS OF THE CITY COUNCIL AS POSTS FOR PURPOSES OF THE CITY ELECTIONS, TO REPEAL CONFLICTING RESOLUTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the duly elected governing authority of the City of Morrow, Georgia (hereinafter the "City") is the Mayor and Council thereof; and

WHEREAS, the governing authority is charged with ensuring local elections are provided for and carried out for the City; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City hereby resolve that the General Election shall be the election held on November 07, 2017 ("General Election"), and that certain positions of the City Council shall be decided in the General Election; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to designate and distinguish all individual council positions for any general, special or runoff election to be held in the future from the effectuation of this Resolution forward, including the upcoming General Election.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Morrow as follows:

- I. In order to make such distinction, the positions of all council members shall be designated as Posts ("Post" or "Posts") to designate and distinguish the Posts from one another for purposes of any such general, special or runoff election, to be held in the future on ballots for such future elections, including the upcoming General Election, and on ballots for the same; and
- II. Such designated Posts shall under no circumstances represent a designation of any geographic boundaries, nor shall the Posts create any voting districts of any kind, nor shall any such Posts create or otherwise designate any residency requirements in any

certain geographic area in order to vote for any such Posts, rather all Posts shall continue to be voted upon by all registered City voters at large; and

III. Such Posts shall be designated and distinguished as follows:

- A. The council seat currently held by Councilman Chris Mills, said seat to be decided on in the 2017 General Election, shall be designated as Post One (1); and
- B. The council seat currently held by Councilwoman Jeanell Bridges, said seat not being decided upon in the upcoming 2017 General Election, shall be designated as Post Two (2) for any general, special or runoff election to be held in the City; and
- C. The council seat currently held by Councilwoman Hang Tran, said seat to be decided on in the 2017 General Election, shall be designated as Post Three (3); and
- D. The council seat currently held by Councilman Larry Ferguson, said seat not being decided upon in the upcoming 2017 General Election, shall be designated as Post Four (4) for any general, special or runoff election to be held in the City.

IV. Such designated and distinguished Posts shall retain such designation and distinction for purposes of any general, special or runoff election to be held in the City, for all time hence forth from the effective date of this Resolution; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the intent of Mayor and Council that all previous resolutions conflicting with this Resolution be repealed; and
