RESOLUTION NO. 2019-05

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF MORROW AND HIS OR HER DESIGNEE TO SIGN CONTRACTS FOR THE USE OF CITY PROPERTY AND PREMISES IN CONJUNCTION WITH ACTIVITY PERTAINING TO FILM INDUSTRY PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the governing body of the of the City of Morrow (“City of Morrow” or “City”) is the Mayor and Council thereof;

WHEREAS, the City of Morrow has the reputation of being a “film friendly” city;

WHEREAS, the city is experiencing an increase in requests from the film industry desiring the use of city property and premises and the majority of these requests require a contract or agreement between the city and production company; and

WHEREAS, the City of Morrow works closely with the experts at the Clayton Film Office and seeks there input and approval on any film project inside the city; and

WHEREAS, the industry is known for providing very little decision making time regarding location selection and the resulting use; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to achieve a more expeditious process for completing contractual agreements so as to maintain the city’s “film friendly” reputation and avoid the loss of film related opportunities.

BE IT RESOLVED that:

Section 1. The City Manager or their designee are hereby authorized on behalf of the Mayor and Council to execute agreements and other related documents or grant permissions

concerning use of City owned property and facilities with all entertainment industries and their affiliates and representatives upon such permission being initially granted by Mayor and Council. The City Manager shall execute such agreements and grant permission only after conferring with the Clayton County Film Office and, when in the opinion of City Manager it is necessary, the City Attorney.


Section 2. This Resolution shall be effective on the date of its approval by the Mayor and Council of the City of Morrow.
